Hole Numbering Designation Drawing.

Finger Holes are Numbered from 1 to 7. Regardless if it is a Right Hand Playing Bansuri or a Left Hand Playing Bansuri.

Right Hand Playing Bansuri.

A Right Hand Playing Transverse Flute, is Positioned to the Right of the Flute Players Body. Right Hand Fingers Close Holes 4, 5, 6, 7. Left Hand Fingers Close Holes 1, 2, 3.

Left Hand Playing Bansuri.

A Left Hand Playing Transverse Flute, is Positioned to the Left of the Flute Players Body. Left Hand Fingers Close Holes 4, 5, 6, 7. Right Hand Fingers Close Holes 1, 2, 3.

Note: On Longer Flutes from F n. Bass. 28 "Length onwards ... Flutes CraftsMen may position Finger Hole 7 to be closed by Thigh, Lap.
