

Flutes Call Out.

Bansuris. North Indian Flutes.

All One World Flutes, **Natural Note** is listed as [n] or no letter following the Scale of the Flute. Example [C n.] or [C. G.]

All One World Flutes, **Sharp Note** is listed as [#]. Example [C #.] or [C #. G #.].

The First Letter of the Flute call out denotes the **Tonic [Indian SA]**. Tonic is the Note played with Top 3 Finger Holes Closed.

The Second Letter denotes the **Key [Western CallOut]**. Key is the Note played with all 6 Finger Holes Closed.

The same Bansuri may be referred , by either its Tonic or Key.

Lengths + Diameters are Approximates. Thread Bindings may vary from Images shown on, One World Flutes WebSite.

Stock Flutes are 7 Finger Hole Design. 6 Finger Hole Flutes are by Special Order Only.

Tonic [Carnatic Sa] = Note Played with Top 2 Finger Holes Closed.

Key [Carnatic Pa] = Note Played with Top 5 Finger Holes Closed.
